1. The City of Woodbury regularly patrols neighborhoods checking on outdoor lawn watering. Sprinkling for Heritage Glen is designated for even-numbered days only. Regulations prohibit watering between 12:00 noon and 5:00 p.m. If you choose to water the lawn around your home, please follow the city regulations. Homeowners in violation of city code will be assessed fines beginning at \$25.00, increasing for each successive violation.
2. Because of the upcoming Labor Day holiday, trash and recycling will be picked up on **Friday, September 8**. To determine
