SEASONAL UPKEEP

In accordance with the contract with Land Maintenance, cleanup of Heritage Glen will be completed as soon as weather and ground conditions permit, but no later than May 15.

1. All debris and leaves will be removed from rock and shrub beds as well as from turf areas.

2. Lawns will be mowed weekly. Grass clippings to be dispersed to insure a neat appearance.
3. Trimming with string trimmers will be completed on a weekly basis to insure a well-kept appearance.
4. Sidewalks, patios and driveways will be blown clear of grass.
5. Fertilizer will be applied three times per season: pre-emergent fertilizer prior to June 10, mid-summer fertilizer prior to August 10 and fall application prior to October 10, with spot spraying as needed.
6. Pruning begins in June, depending upon weather conditions and early growth. Flowering shrubs will be pruned after flowering has ended.
7. Sidewalks and curbs will be edged twice during the mowing season.

PROBLEMS OR ISSUES
